




To see any new changes to a web page...  
you may need to “refresh” your Internet browser.

Why? Because when you visit a website often, your browser keeps the page in a cache and doesn't refresh unless you ask it to or unless a determined amount of days have passed (depending on your settings). Click the icon shown below for the browser you're using.

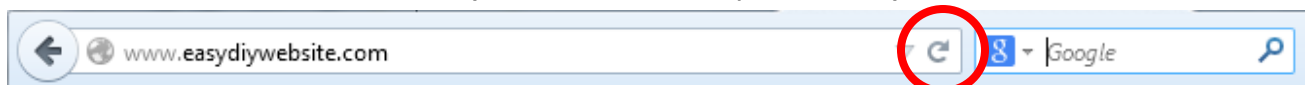
*NOTE: The screenshots below show what you should see near the top of your screen. Your screen may look slightly different, but you should still see a “refresh” button in this area.*
